Building update

As you will be aware, our initial plan was to move into our new extension after Easter this year, unfortunately we have had to wait a little longer. It was initially hoped that there would be enough time to complete external aspects of the project over Easter when pupils were off- site, however, it just didn't work out in the end. Whilst it is envisioned that the new extension will be completed in mid-June, final external works can only commence in earnest when the prefabs have been moved off-site. These external works will include a new enclosed hard/soft-surface play area together with an enclosed sensory garden, both will extend onto the area of ground where the prefabs currently lie. The completion date for the external elements of the project is mid July. The latest advice from the Design Team is to wait until September to move into the new building, at which point the project will be completed in its entirety. We thank you for your continued patience and understanding and we look forward to extending an invitation to you all to view our wonderful new facilities. It suffices to say it will be worth the wait.

Updated School Calendar
