Class Teachers for September

As the main Redeployment Panel has yet to clear in the Diocese of Killaloe, the Department of Education will not permit schools in the Diocese to finalise decisions around the recruitment of specific teaching positions in schools across the Diocese. A substantial number of schools are affected by the delay this year. Unfortunately, this situation is outside of our control. Whilst I would love to be in a position to let you know who your child's Class Teacher will be in September, I am not in a position to do so just yet. Once we get the go ahead from the Department, it is a straight forward process and I anticipate I will be back in touch early July with our usual Class Teacher list.

Due to the large number of pupils in the senior end of the school, both Fourth Class and Fifth Class will be divided this coming year, so as to maintain an equitable balance of pupils in each classroom, keeping the pupil/teacher ratio lower than it would be if we kept classes together. This decision is made with your child's best interests at heart. Pupils in Fourth and Fifth Classes will have a note for parents in their school bag this afternoon.

Classes will be grouped as follows for the coming school year:

- Junior and Senior Infants
- First and Second
- Third and Fourth
- Fourth and Fifth
- Fifth and Sixth
